**Re: Notice of Date for Submission of eTariff
Baseline Schedules under Docket No. RM01-5-000**

Dear Ms. Bose:

Pursuant to the Notice of Date for Submission of Transitional Schedules (“Notice”) issued on December 1, 2009, by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) in the above-referenced docket, PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (“PJM”) has coordinated with the several ISOs and RTOs in order to avoid clustering of the individual baseline filings by each RTO/ISO.¹

In the Notice, the Commission invites parties to submit by January 22, 2010, proposed schedules for making baseline electronic filings pursuant to Order No. 714.² The Notice states that Commission staff will honor a consensus agreement so long as the filers are generally spread over the six-month transition period.

Accordingly, PJM is authorized to offer the following proposed baseline tariff filing scheduled on behalf of the Participating RTOs/ISOs:

1. PJM proposes to make its baseline filings on August 10, 2010.
2. Midwest ISO proposes to make its baseline filings on July 19, 2010.


¹ Specifically, PJM coordinated with the following RTOs/ISOs: (i) ISO New England, Inc. (“ISO-NE”); (ii) Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (“Midwest ISO”); (iii) New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (“NYISO”); California Independent System Operator (“CAISO”); and (iv) Southwest Power Pool, Inc. (“SPP”) (together referred to herein as the “Participating RTOs/ISOs”).

3. SPP proposes to make its baseline filings on April 19, 2010.³
4. ISO-NE proposes to make its baseline filings on August 13, 2010.
5. NYISO proposes to make its baseline filings on June 2, 2010.⁴
6. CAISO proposes to make its baseline filings on May 5, 2010.

Please provide written confirmation that the Participating RTOs/ISOs' proposed eTariff baseline filing dates are acceptable with the Commission. Should there be any questions or need for additional information, please contact me.
