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Report Descriptions Supporting Details

This document describes the field descriptions for files generated for the Standard Market Design Market Information Server and World-wide Web. These reports provide Market Participants with certain information concerning the operation of New England’s wholesale electricity markets and bulk power system operations. These files will be available to registered market Participants via ISO New England’s FTP file server or via the ISO Web site. Standard Settlement Additional Detail

Each report may contain three sections = Calculation, Allocation, and Additional Information.

The **SS_GENERICSS** (sample file) - This is not an actual report file. This is only a sample generic file showing all columns being populated. It should be used solely as a guide. The Generic Report Description is provided to display all columns and corresponding definitions that could be found in any of the Standard Settlement reports.

The specific report descriptions for the Standard Settlement M IS reports display only those columns and corresponding definitions for those columns populated by the specific Standard Settlement item, where all remaining columns will be returned but with a blank value.

The Additional Information section of each Standard Settlement report is neither defined in the Generic Report Description nor the Specific Report Description as it provides supplemental information, as needed, previously provided in the Bill Job Aid. All text fields have a 200 character maximum.

Historical Bid/Offer Publishing under Standard Market Design

This document describes certain text files that are generated by ISO New England (ISO-NE) that detail the historical bid/offer data submitted by NEPOOL Participants to ISO-NE. The advent of Standard Market Design (SMD) on March 1, 2003 significantly altered the type and quantity of information that is submitted by market participants. This release (Version 5.0) documents the available historical offer data associated with Real Time Hourly offers for Energy from generators and Real Time Hourly Bids for load from Asset Related Demand. It also documents a new report that details masked historical bid and offer data for real-time imports and exports to and from the New England Control area.

Publication of these historical data complies with a directive issued by the FERC in its Order on Complaint and Conditionally Accepting Market Rule Revisions, 92 FERC ¶ 61,065 at 61,201 (2000).

In compliance with the FERC Order in Docket No. ER07-1245-000, issued on October 18, 2007, the ISO has shortened the time lag associated with the posting of historical bids and offers into the wholesale markets administered by it. Historical bid and offer data will be posted on the first day of the fourth month following the operating month consistent with that order.

ISO-NE publishes historical bid and offer data monthly. ISO-NE intends to publish additional historical bid and offer data in the future, and will update this document as those publications are made, or as output file formats change.

A complete description of each report is included in this document. Sample CSV files and MS Excel formatted files renditions for published historical bids and offers are posted separately in a file called 'SMD Bid and Offer Data Samples.xls'.

A set of Excel templates and sample historical bid/offer reports is contained in the WinZip compatible archive files located at the same web URL as this document. Also, templates and sample reports for markets that have expired are contained in the WinZip compatible archive files.

Report Delivery and Retention

A complete set of files for each month will be available on the ISO New England website in Comma-Separated Values (CSV) Delimited Format, and, in some cases, compressed into one archive file. ISO-NE currently maintains archives that begin with March 2003 – the beginning of Standard Market Design.
